

OPERATING REGULATIONS

RATES APPLICABLE FROM 1 JANUARY 2024

Definition of passenger categories

Islanders: permanent residents of the island in accordance with the appendix to this public service delegation contract.

Other categories: all passengers not falling into the above category.

Pedestrian fares from the mainland to the island (excluding islanders) are subject to a tax for the protection of sensitive areas, known as the Barnier tax, as well as a passenger fee. All the following fares include VAT..

Islander Fare

Tickets are personal. They are issued on presentation of a permanent resident card for the island issued by the Vedettes de Bréhat company.

Young island student" passes are issued to students living on the island. To qualify for this fare, students must show proof of school attendance (student card or other document) and proof that they are part of their parents' tax islander household.

Please note: any fraudulent use or purchase of a ticket and/or island card on behalf of another person will result in the immediate cancellation of the island card (see Penalties). *Island cards are nominative and can only be used by one person. Cut-out cards are not valid and will not be accepted for boarding.

Business fares

Company" passes are issued on presentation of the K-bis extract or any other document proving that the passes are for use by a company. Company" passes are for professional use only. Any private use will be subject to refusal of boarding by the Vedettes de Bréhat company (see Penalties at the end of the document).

Group rates

Group rates apply to groups of 20 adults or more, or to school groups of 10 children or more. The Vedettes de Bréhat company grants free admission to one accompanying adult for every 25 paying adults or one accompanying adult for every 10 children in school groups. Bus drivers are also free.

Promotional fares

Promotional fares are applied at the discretion of Les Vedettes de Bréhat on the basis of demand, periods, booking rates or any other commercial opportunity.

Passenger ticket booking conditions

LTickets must be paid for at the time of booking. It is the payment of the ticket that conditions the reservation of the place on board the ships.

Conditions for cancelling or changing the date of travel

In accordance with article L 121-21-8 of the French Consumer Code, tickets are not subject to a right of withdrawal. A ticket cannot be reimbursed, even in the event of loss or theft, nor can it be taken back or exchanged, except in the event of cancellation of a departure.

In case of cancellation by the company, only the price of the ticket will be refunded. This refund will only be made to the original purchaser against return of the ticket. In all cases, no costs of any kind whatsoever will be refunded or compensated. The shipping company reserves the right, without prior notice, to cancel a crossing or change its timetable (weather conditions, technical problems).

Changes to crossings are only possible subject to availability. There is no charge for changing the crossing date and the change is valid until 31 December of the year in which the tickets were purchased.

Luggage

Luggage is the responsibility of the passenger and must be labelled. Luggage must be labelled so that it can be identified, particularly if it is forgotten on the ship. Luggage passage is free of charge. There is no limit to the number of items of luggage per person, but they must be in proportion to the number of people travelling. If the number of items of luggage is deemed excessive by the Vedettes de Bréhat company, passengers may be required to pay a "parcel" rate.

Parcels, trolleys, bicycles

Trolleys or parcels (excluding passenger baggage) of moderate size that cannot be carried will be charged in addition to the ticket price per person. They must be accompanied by their owners. They remain under the full responsibility of the passenger when boarding or disembarking or for the duration of the journey.

All bulky parcels are not transported by the Vedettes de Bréhat company but by the Barge de Bréhat. Parcels that are too large may be refused boarding and are left to the discretion of the company's employees.

The passage of bicycles is subject to several time conditions:

- > Passage to the island of Bréhat is authorised until 9.30am, or from 1.30pm for those staying on the island for at least one night.
- > The return journey to the mainland must be completed by 4pm maximum.

If these times are not respected, the Vedettes de Bréhat company reserves the right to refuse access to the ship or to postpone departure to a more convenient time.

Special case: Folding bicycles are not affected by this obligation unless they are folded when boarding the boat. They must remain folded throughout the journey.

Pets

From 1 January 2022, there will be a charge for animals. This fee does not apply to animals transported in hand-carried crates. It applies in all other cases, regardless of the size of the animals. Animals must be kept on a lead in the holds and throughout the journey. It is forbidden for pets to sit on seats reserved for customers.

Boat crossing for a coffin

The passage of an empty coffin follows the official timetable published by the Vedettes de Bréhat company. A full coffin, on the other hand, will pass through on an additional departure reserved for funeral directors and family members. In this case, the departure time is agreed in advance between the company and the funeral directors or the family.

Parcels for companies on the island

Parcels (excluding fresh produce) destined for companies on the island of Bréhat must be delivered to the Arcouest ferry terminal before the 8.15am departure.

Goods transported by the Vedettes de Bréhat company is at the customer's risk and it is the customer's responsibility to check that they are in good condition at the time of delivery.

The company Vedettes de Bréhat cannot be held responsible if the non-execution or the delay in the execution of one of its obligations described in the present general conditions of sale results from a case of force majeure (within the meaning of article 1148 of the French Civil Code).

Medical evacuations, medical analyses, fire brigade

Emergency medical evacuations are not billed by the company. These are carried out only during the cruising hours, according to the timetables published by the company. However, people are picked up at additional departure times not mentioned in the published timetables. Vedettes de Bréhat accepts no responsibility for the care of patients.

Medical analyses are carried free of charge by the Vedettes de Bréhat company.

However, it is the responsibility of the relevant professionals to arrange for and receive the tests. The company cannot be held responsible if the tests are not collected in time by the people concerned.

The passage of the fire brigade is free of charge when the crossing is carried out in the exercise of its duties or on a professional basis. Firefighters must be dressed for work in order to benefit from this free service.

PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THESE RULES

Any customer who does not hold a valid ticket must, in addition to regularising their tickets, immediately pay a fine representing five (5) times the price of the normal single non-insular passenger ticket. In the event of refusal, the ticket holder may be taken to court in accordance with the relevant procedure.

In the event of fraudulent use of a season ticket (e.g. use of an island season ticket by a person who does not meet the allocation criteria or use of a company season ticket for private travel), the season ticket will automatically be confiscated by the Vedettes de Bréhat company.

This does not exempt you from paying the aforementioned fixed fine and regularising your ticket. Any person benefiting from the island fare who purchases an island ticket or card on behalf of another person will have their island card immediately withdrawn.

APPENDIX

ISSUE OF ISLAND CARDS

The benefit of an island card may be granted in accordance with the following conditions:
The applicant must provide an income tax notice stating that he/she lives on the island of Bréhat for tax purposes as his/her main residence.

This document also specifies the persons attached to the same tax household (spouse, children including students up to the age of 25, etc.).

If you have only recently arrived on the island and are unable to provide proof of tax status, a provisional card may be issued on presentation of the following documents:

- > a notarised deed certifying the purchase of a residence, or a copy of the declaration of completion of works in the case of a building, or a copy of a rental contract;
- > a declaration on honour that the person undertakes to reside on the island for at least 6 months a year and to make it their principal residence.

This transitional situation may not last more than one year. The provisional card will become definitive on presentation of the above-mentioned tax documents.

In addition to the above-mentioned documents, the application file includes:

- > Copy of the family record book ;
- > Copies of the identity documents related to each applicant ;
- > If applicable, a copy of a PACS contract;
- > A passport photo of each person.

For the creation of new island passes, the island pass application form is to be collected and handed in at the Arcouest ticket office.

The application will be sent to the Region Bretagne for examination and validation.

The form can also be downloaded from the "Practical Info" section of the www.vedettesdebrehat.com website.

The delegatee will monitor the process and renew the cards annually on presentation of the last tax assessment.
